	<p>A dragonfly spreads its legs into a basket formation.</p> <p>Additional Information: Dragonflies are flying insects that can move in any direction: forwards, backwards, sideways, and up or down. They are predators that use their legs mid-flight in a basket formation to catch other insects, like mosquitoes.</p>	
	<p>The impalas allogroom one another.</p> <p>Additional Information: Impalas are animals similar to gazelles that live in the savannas and woodlands of Africa. They engage in a behavior called allogrooming, which is a behavior in which animals groom one another for hygiene and social bonding.</p>	



A ladybug utilizes its tarsi to walk upside down.

Additional Information: Ladybugs often "play possum" or pretend to be dead by turning upside down. They have sticky pads on their legs called tarsi that allow them to grip microscopic bumps on surfaces.
