

BUILD TENS (COMBINE) GAME BOARD A

K-2nd Grade Mathematics

How to play:

1. Shuffle the Tens Cards and put them in a pile face down.
2. Player A: Draw two Tens cards (e.g., 40 and 20).
3. Build each number using linking cubes or tiny ten frames.
4. Put the sets together and count how many tens there are in total.
5. Say the addition statements out loud using tens language AND number language. Example:
 - 4 tens and 2 tens makes 6 tens
 - $40 + 20 = 60$
6. Record your combinations on your recording sheet.
7. Switch roles and repeat.
