## Cause and Effect Chart

Cause	Effect
Forced <b>relocation</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Moved from ancestral homelands to <b>reservations</b></li> <li>● Traditions and ways of life tied to specific places became harder to practice</li> </ul>
More and more settlers arrived	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Land became more and more scarce</li> <li>● <b>Indigenous nations</b> lost large portions of their territory</li> </ul>
Broke <b>treaties</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Left with poor land and few buffalo, deer, and elk to hunt</li> <li>● Tried to run away but were forced back</li> </ul>
Government control	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Not allowed to practice their <b>sacred</b> ceremonies</li> <li>● Limited their sovereignty and ability to govern themselves fully</li> </ul>
Sent children to boarding schools	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Children separated from their families and punished for speaking their languages</li> <li>● Disrupted the passing down of language, stories, and cultural teachings</li> </ul>
Tried to force <b>Indigenous</b> people to adopt American customs	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>● Cultural practices, clothing, spiritual ceremonies, and languages were discouraged or banned</li> <li>● There was pressure on communities to change or forget their identities</li> </ul>
