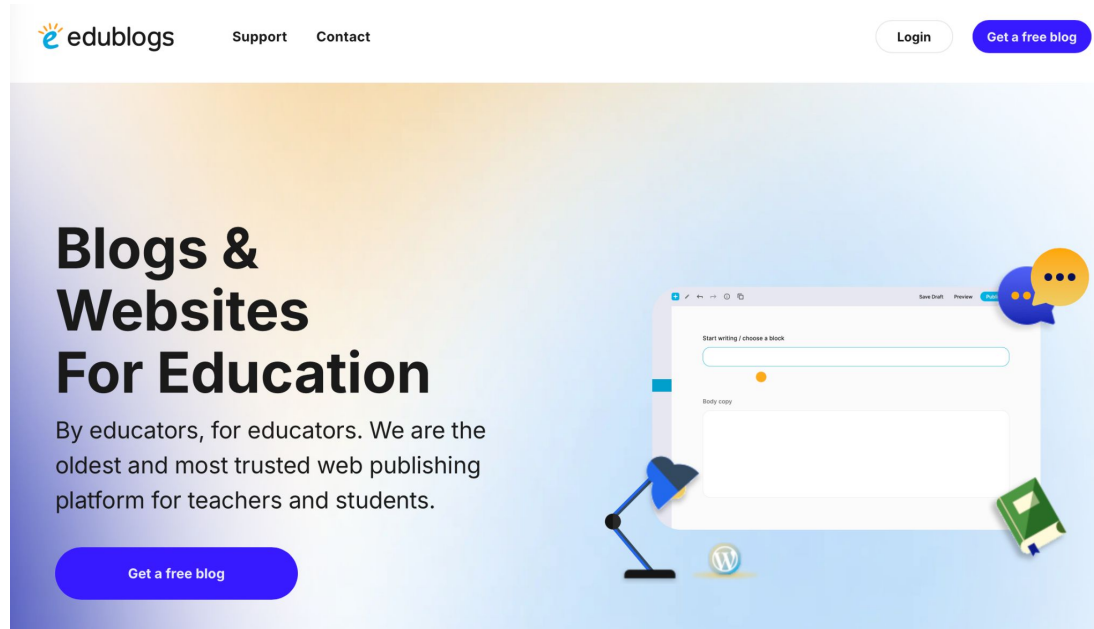


Directions to Create an Edublog

Create an Account

1. Go to www.edublogs.org and create a free blog for your class.

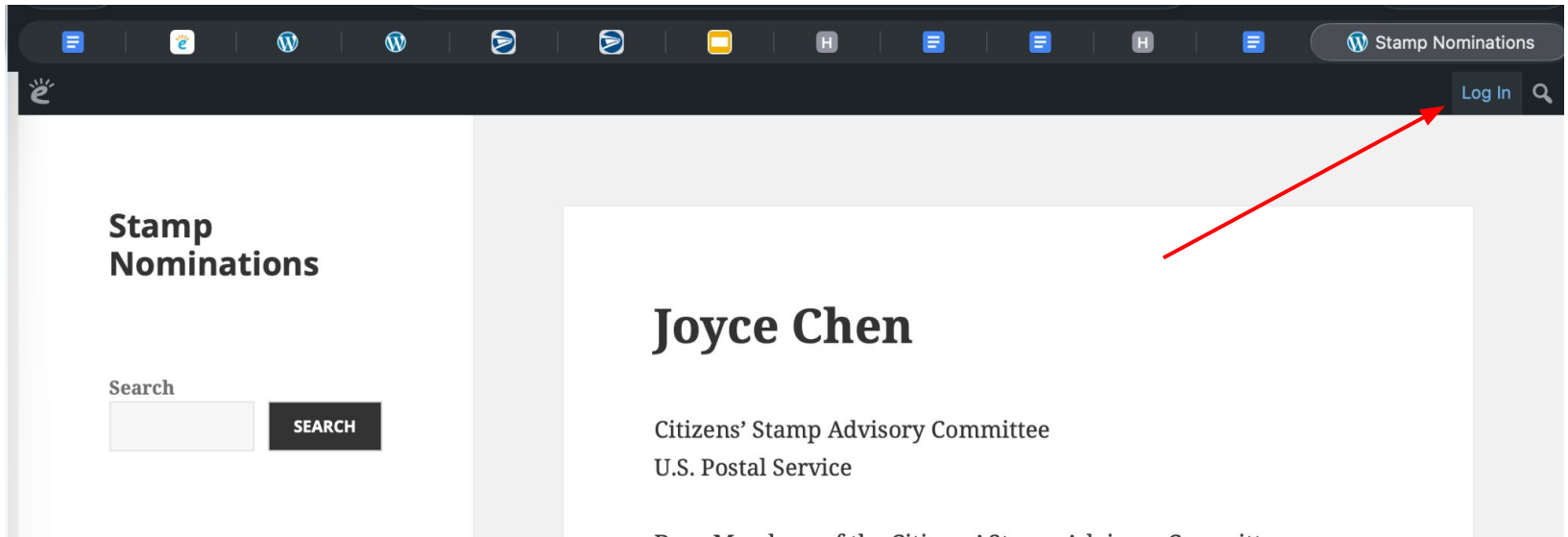


Share Link

2. Share the unique hyperlink to your class's blog with the class.

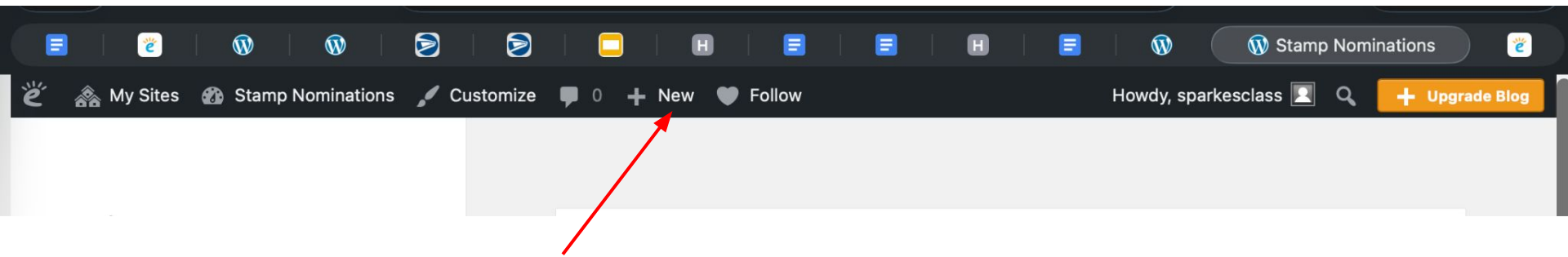
Have Students Log In

3. Have students click the "Log In" button in the upper right hand corner to log into the blog and be able to post. Students will use their student email to log in.



Create a Blog Post

4. Click "New" to create a new blog post.



Format and Add Content to the Blog Post

5. Add the individual's name as the title.


Then copy paste the text from the letter into the blog.

If you created a visual for your stamp, click the "+" button to add an image.



Publish Blog

6. Once you have uploaded all the content to the blog, click "Publish" to make the site accessible to other students with access to the blog.
