### **Exit West Group Research Project**

Mohsin Hamid shows through his novel *Exit West* that fiction has the power to foster empathy and understanding about the refugee crisis. But, as Viet Thanh Nguyen says in his introduction to *The Displaced*, "Literature changes the world of readers and writers, but literature does not change the world until people get out of their chairs, go out in the world, and do something to transform the conditions of which the literature speaks" (20). To answer Nguyen's call, you and your classmates will conduct research that can inform others about the crisis and how to get involved.

Your group will select a country with a current refugee crisis, considering the following questions:

- What are its primary causes (political, social, environmental)?
- Where are the refugees in your selected country fleeing to? What challenges do they face there?
- How has the world responded to this crisis? Consider the actions taken by the global community, the policies of host countries, and the role of humanitarian aid organizations.
- How can individuals take action in response to this crisis?

#### Your website should:

- Include a combination of data and statistics, images/videos, and words
- Provide refugee testimony, either through embedded videos or quoted material
- Include interactive elements like maps, infographics, or surveys
- Be organized, engaging and easy to navigate for users
