

INFO GAP CARD SET (TWO-STEP WORD PROBLEMS)
2nd Grade Mathematics

Context card #1:

Iman and her sister were picking mangos from their mango trees in their yard. Iman's sister picked fewer mangos than Iman did. How many mangos did the girls pick altogether?

Info card #1:

# of mangos picked by Iman	44
how many fewer mangos Iman's sister picked than Iman did	26
# of mango trees in yard	8

Context card #2:

The 2nd graders in Ms. Lozado's class got ready for a classroom party. They blew up balloons in the morning and afternoon. The next day they realized that some balloons popped! How many balloons do they have now?

Info card #2:

# balloons blown up in morning	44
# balloons popped	39
# balloons blown up in afternoon	29
# 2nd graders at the party	35

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Context card #3:

Angel was helping the librarian sort books. How many more picture books and nature books combined are there than chapter books?

Info card #3:

# of nature books	25
# of books checked out	50
# of chapter books	18
# of picture books	31

Context card #4:

Nneka was looking at a box of math manipulatives in her classroom. In the box were counting bears, two-color counters, and connecting cubes. How many connecting cubes are there?

Info card #4:

# of two-colored counters	27
# of counting bears	23
# of manipulatives in the box	100
# of rulers	30

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Context card #5:

Preston had a pencil box that could hold a lot of pencils. He had some pencils in his box, but some broke. How many more pencils does he need in order to fill his pencil box?

Info card #5:

# of pencils in Preston's box	32
# of pencils in Aimee's box	57
# of pencils box can hold	60
# of broken pencils	9

Context card #6:

Noah was decorating the school hallway with paper chains in preparation for the Latinx Heritage Month celebration. He used orange, yellow, and green paper and needed a certain number of chains to fill the hallway. How many paper chains are green?

Info card #6:

# of orange chains	43
# of chains needed to fill hallway	82
# of yellow chains	18
# of kids helping decorate	14

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Context card #7:

Hunter's family donated school supplies at the start of the year, including pencils, boxes of crayons, and erasers. How many supplies did he donate?

Info card #7:

# of people in Hunter's family	6
# of pencils donated	49
# of boxes of crayons donated	26
# of erasers donated	25

Context card #8:

Rakesh was swimming the entire length of a pool. He swam, took a break, then swam again. How many more feet does he need to swim in order to swim the length of the pool?

Info card #8:

# of feet swam first	44
Length of the diving board in feet	10
# of feet swam after break	25
Length of the pool in feet	91

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Context card #9:

Fatima and her brother were collecting eggs from their chicken coop. Fatima collected more eggs than her brother. How many eggs did they collect?

Info card #9:

# of chickens in the coop	34
# of eggs Fatima's brother collected	273
How many more eggs Fatima collected than her brother	29

Context card #10:

Hana was rolling pasta with her grandmother. They each rolled out some pieces of pasta and then they ate some. How many pieces of pasta do they have left?

Info card #10:

# pieces of pasta rolled by grandma	27
# of pieces of pasta eaten	38
# pieces of pasta rolled by Hana	32
# of ounces of sauce used	29
