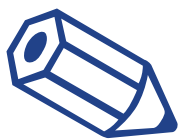

Add

Ask yourself: "What can I add to make my writing clearer or more complete?"

When to use:

- Writing needs more explanation
- Missing information or a linking word (like *because* or *also*)

Example: I think changemakers make their communities stronger because they use their ideas and actions to help others and solve problems.



Delete

Ask yourself: "Is there anything extra or off-topic?"

When to use:

- Repetition of the same words, phrases, or ideas
- Writing goes off topic

Example: Changemakers help others, ~~and we go to~~ school.



Change

Ask yourself: "Can I say this in a better way?"

When to use:

- A word or phrase is not clear
- Make the message stronger by using different words

Example: Changemakers help their communities. → Changemakers make their communities better by solving problems, helping others, and sharing new ideas.



Rearrange

Ask yourself: "Would my writing make more sense in a different order?"

When to use:

- Important details are out of order
- Words, phrases, sentences or ideas are confusing

Example: They help people and solve problems. That's why I think changemakers make communities better. → I think changemakers make communities better. They help people and solve problems.
