

## Sample Argumentative Multi-Paragraph Outline

**Prompt:** Write an argumentative essay in which you take a clear position on this question: Do book bans help or harm young people? Support your position with information from at least two of the articles you have read.

Claim: Book bans harm young people by preventing them from seeing themselves in stories and by limiting their opportunities to understand diverse perspectives.

Reason 1: Prevents some young people from seeing their own lives represented in books

Topic Sentence: First, book bans harm young people by keeping them from seeing themselves and their experiences reflected in stories, which can affect their sense of belonging.
