Supporting Body Paragraph 1: T-E-A-L

Topic sentence	Assimilation – makes the students feel ashamed of their identity
Evidence	"Then I slunk into the closet and practiced the Sausalito two-step in secret, a private mass of twitch and foam. Mouth shut-shoes on feet! Mouth shut-shoes on feet! Mouthshutmouthshot ..." (238).
Analysis	<p>Zoom in:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- "twitch and foam" → indicates that the dance feels unnatural to Claudette- repetition of "Mouth shut" and the elimination of spaces in "Mouthshotmouthshot" → Claudette works hard to resist her natural wolf instincts <p>Zoom out:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">- Learning to dance the Sausalito two-step → makes Claudette feel like her native wolf identity is shameful- Learning the dance → she tries to unlearn her native identity
Last Sentence	Assimilation – harmful b/c characters feel hatred and shame toward native identity

Supporting Body Paragraph 2: T-E-A-L

<p>Topic sentence</p>	<p>Assimilation – makes students feel like their identity is being erased</p>
<p>Evidence</p>	<p>"Someone was coming in and erasing us. We sprayed and sprayed every morning; and every night, we returned to the same ammonia eradication. We couldn't make our scent stick here; it made us feel invisible" (230).</p>
<p>Analysis</p>	<p>Zoom in: -"ammonia eradication" and "invisible" → diction signals erasure</p> <p>Zoom out: -Characters are losing connection to their native identities as a result of erasure</p>
<p>Last Sentence</p>	<p>Assimilation harmful → wolf identity erased → loss of connection</p>
