

Rewritten Scene Brainstorm Graphic Organizer

• What scene will you rewrite from <i>In the Time of the Butterflies</i>? • Which sister was the original narrator of the scene? • Which sister will be the narrator in the rewritten scene?	• Scene (including page numbers): The first flashback (pages 8–9) • Original narrator: Dedé • New narrator: Patria
• What does your chosen sister say/do in the original scene? • What are your chosen sister's thoughts and emotions in the chosen scene? How does she feel about the events unfolding? What are her motivations?	• Patria is sitting outside with the family. • She asks her father what he predicts for her future. • Quickly takes the question back after her mother explains that she does not believe in fortunes because of her religion. • Interested in the conversation her family is having about the future because she is curious about her own.
• What are the defining traits, beliefs, values, and past experiences of your chosen sister?	• Quiet • Religious • Family-oriented
• What details from the original scene will you keep? • What additional details or insights could you incorporate to show your understanding of the chosen sister's perspective?	• The family will still be sitting outside on a cool, clear, moonlit night. • Patria will ask about her future. • Patria will give her perspective on each family member. ◦ Father: kind, helpful, generous ◦ Dedé: practical ◦ Mate: the sweet baby of the family ◦ Mother: faithful ◦ Minerva: clever • Patria will relay her internal thoughts about her future.

- What is your chosen sister's unique narrative voice? What tone, emotions, symbols, imagery, etc., differentiate her voice from her sister's voices?
