Analysis		Each piece of evidence is followed by two to five sentences that analyze by: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • zooming in: break down the quotation • zooming out: explain how the evidence supports the claim in the topic sentence 	
Last Sentence		The paragraph concludes with a last sentence that begins with a concluding phrase and reiterates the main ideas of the paragraph.	
Paragraph Structure		The paragraph is structured using T-E-A-L: topic sentence, evidence, analysis, and a last sentence.
