## Single Point Argumentative Writing Rubric

<b>Literary Analysis</b>		I review and reflect on literary and/or informational texts to identify strong evidence that relates to my thematic topic and supports a literary analysis argument.	
<b>Counter-Claim / Rebuttal</b>		I address a counterclaim that strengthens my argument by showing why there is more support for my claim than for alternate or opposing claims.	
<b>Introduction</b>		My introduction paragraph engages my reader, contextualizes and previews my argument, and clearly states my claim.	
<b>Conclusion</b>		My conclusion paragraph restates my claim, summarizes the main points of my argument, and explains my argument's overall significance.	
<b>Language</b>		I revise my work to create compound sentences that use active voice correctly and effectively.
