 Introduction: Hook our audience. Consider one or more of the following strategies: Begin with an anecdote that connects with your belief If it's a belief you think your audience never thinks about, start off by invoking something they do think about a lot and relate that concept to your idea Open with a surprising or interesting fact Demonstrate your credibility to be speaking on the subject in an engaging way 	
 Body: List out 2–3 key points in the order that makes the most sense for your speech. Consider using the following strategies to support your points*: Using a personal anecdote or real-life example to provide evidence based on actual observations and experiences Using at least one piece of credible research to support your reasoning and develop your credibility as a speaker 	
Conclusion: Propose a solution and/or make a call to action by telling your audience what they should do next and how their/others' lives will be better if they do so. Consider one or more of the following strategies: • Tell your audience how they might think differently about something and the impact it would have • Tell your audience what actions they should take and the impact it would have
