

# TENS TOSS GAME BOARD

## K-2nd Grade Mathematics

### How to play:

1. Shuffle the Tens Cards and spread them out face down.
2. Player A: Drop a pompom on the cards and pick the one it lands on (or closest to).
  - Build the number with stacks of 10 linking cubes.
  - Draw a +10 or -10 card.
  - Add or remove 1 ten.
  - Record your starting number, new number, and an equation.
3. Player B: Take your turn the same way as Player A did in step 2.
4. Both players: Share your equations and agree or disagree, explaining why.
5. Keep playing until all Tens Cards are used.
6. Use your completed recording sheet to discuss any patterns you notice.
