
A ladybug crawls on a green leaf. (6)

Physical Characteristics

- Egg – Laid on leaves
- Larva – Looks like a tiny black or gray alligator.
- Pupa – The larva attaches to a surface and begins transforming.
- Adult – Emerges fully grown and ready to eat pests. (7)
